#### Australian Securities and Investments Commission Corporations Act 2001 — Paragraph 911A(2)(I) — Exemption

Under paragraph 911A(2)(1) of the Corporations Act 2001 the Australian Securities and Investments Commission exempts Waste Management N.Z. Limited (ARBN 091 539 589) ("WAM") from the requirement to hold an Australian financial services licence for the provision of general financial product advice in connection with the distribution of documents by WAM on or about 2 May 2006 to Australian shareholders of WAM in relation to a proposed amalgamation under Part XIII of the Companies Act 1993 (NZ).

This instrument takes effect on gazettal.
