Non-Recognised Accountant applying for a limited Australian Financial Services (AFS) licence to provide limited financial services.

These instructions relate to the completion of the Form FS01 – *Application for an AFS licence* (FS01) for Non-Recognised Accountants applying for a limited AFS licence. Please refer to Information Sheet 179 Applying for a limited AFS licence.

BUSINESS DESCRIPTION PROOF
