


Log in using your email address and password.




How to cancel a business name

- 3. Select **Go** to continue.








How to cancel a business name





Declare

- 2. If you agree, tick the boxes next to the declaration to continue.
- 3. Select your authority for submitting the transaction.
- 4. Select Next to continue.
