Guide: Notification of cessation, winding up or dissolution of a foreign company or registered Australian body

This guide does not form part of the form. It is included by ASIC to assist you in completing and lodging the Form 407.

Signature	<p>Registered Australian body This form must be signed by a director or equivalent or secretary.</p> <p>Foreign company This form must be signed by a director, secretary or local agent or a director or secretary of a company appointed as local agent.</p> <p>A local agent signing for a foreign company that is in liquidation or has been dissolved must be the local agent immediately before the commencement of the liquidation proceedings.</p>
Lodgement period	<p>Within 7 days of ceasing to carry on business in Australia, or within 1 month of winding up or dissolution/deregistration.</p> <p>If a company in its place of origin has started winding up proceedings, two Forms 407 will ultimately be required to be lodged with ASIC. The first Form 407 is lodged at the commencement of winding up proceeding to notify of the appointment of the liquidator. The second Form 407 is lodged when the company has been dissolved.</p>
Lodgement fee	<p>Nil if lodged within the prescribed lodging period.</p>
Late lodgement fee	<p>Late fees will apply if you notify a change outside of the lodgement period.</p> <p>For information on fees refer to www.asic.gov.au/forms.</p> <p>A receipt will not be issued unless requested. Generally, a form is not regarded as being lodged until it is received and accepted by ASIC as being in compliance with s1274(8) of the Corporations Act 2001.</p>
How to provide additional information	<p>Photocopied Form 407 pages If there is insufficient space in any section of the form, you may photocopy the relevant page(s) and submit as part of this lodgement.</p> <p>Annexures</p> <p>To make any annexure conform to the regulations, you must</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. use A4 size paper of white or light pastel colour with a margin of at least 10mm on all sides2. show the company name and ACN or ARBN3. number the pages consecutively4. print or type in BLOCK letters in dark blue or black ink so that the document is clearly legible when photocopied5. mark the annexure with an identifying letter or symbol eg a,b,c or 1,2,3 etc.6. endorse the annexure with the words: This annexure (mark) of (number) pages referred to in form (form number and title)7. sign and date the annexure <p>The annexure must be signed by the same person(s) who signed the form.</p>
