<b>Signature</b>	This form must be signed by a director or secretary of the company.	
<b>Lodging period</b>	Within 14 days of appointment.	
<b>Lodging fee</b>	\$36 within the prescribed lodging period. Full payment must be received with this form. A receipt will not be issued unless requested.	
<b>Late fees</b>	The late fees are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• \$70 for up to one month late</li><li>• \$292 for over one month late.</li></ul> A form is not considered lodged until it is received and accepted by ASIC as complying with s1274(8) of the <i>Corporations Act 2001</i> . A receipt will not be issued unless requested.
