Lodgement period	As soon as practicable after the change.
Lodgement fees	A lodgement fee applies to this form.

	A form is not considered lodged until it is received and accepted by ASIC as being in compliance with s1274(8) of the Corporations Act 2001. A receipt will not be issued unless requested.

Additional information	For the resignation of compliance plan auditor – the auditor must first obtain consent from ASIC to their resignation using Form 5113 Application for consent from ASIC to resign as compliance plan auditor.
	For removal of compliance plan auditor - the responsible entity of a registered scheme must first obtain consent from ASIC to remove the auditor of the compliance plan from office using Form 5112 <i>Application for consent from ASIC to remove compliance plan auditor.</i>
	The resignation or removal will only take effect on the day, following ASIC's consent, when the following disclosure requirements are made by the responsible entity, for a registered scheme:
	 if the registered scheme is a disclosing entity, the responsible entity must give a continuous disclosure notice, that would not deal with other matters, to ASIC and any relevant market operator for the scheme (RG 26.74 and RG 26.75); and
	 if the registered scheme is <u>not</u> a disclosing entity, the responsible entity must give notice to the scheme's members (RG 26.76):
	 by a public notice displayed prominently on the responsible entity's website where the notice can reasonably be readily located and accessed by members of the scheme; by email; or in writing. In both instances, the notice must contain: details of the outgoing auditor; details of the proposed incoming auditor; and
	the reason for the change in auditor.
	ASIC consent is not required for removal of a compliance plan auditor where the auditor has become ineligible to act under s601HG(2) of the <i>Corporations Act 2001</i> .
