How to register a business name with a transfer number

- [ASIC Connect](#) is the online system used to manage your business name.
- You can lodge an application for a business name online from your [ASIC Connect](#) account.
- Before you start, you must have the transfer number from the previous business name owner. If you have not received the transfer number you will need to contact the previous business name owner.
- You must have an Australian Business Number (ABN) or an ABN application reference number to apply for a business name (unless an exemption applies).
- You can pay for your business name registration fee online by credit card or later by BPAY or invoice.
- This example is for an individual business name owner (sole trader). Other business name owner types will result in different screens and questions being asked.
- For further help using [ASIC Connect](#), use the  button at the top right-hand side of the screen.




Log in



Apply for a business name

Apply for a business name

1. Read the information about applying for a business name.
2. Tick the boxes under **Things to be aware of**.
3. Select **Get Started** to start your application.

1 Apply for a Business Name

Before you start

The application takes an average of 15 - 20 minutes to complete. You can choose to save and exit the application if you cannot complete it in one sitting. If you do, the information you entered will be saved for 90 days but the business name you entered will not be held and will be available for someone else to register.

Resumes your application by logging on to your account. Go to 'myTransactions' under the 'Lodgements and notifications' tab to resume your application.

Who can lodge an application?

The proposed business name holder or a person authorised by them may lodge the application. Here are the steps to apply for a business name and the information you will need on hand.

Step by step information is available in our [How to apply for a business name guide](#).

Step 1 Enter the Australian Business Number (ABN) or ABN application reference number of the entity that will hold the business name

[Find the ABN before you start](#). Don't have an ABN? [Visit the Australian Business Register to apply](#).

If you apply with an ABN application reference number, the business name will be held (but not registered) until your ABN application has been determined by the ABR.

Step 2 Enter the proposed business name and decide if you want to register it for 1 or 3 years

To get ready you can [check to see if the name is available](#).

Enter the business name you would like to register and select 'Check name availability'. Business name registration is case sensitive. You must enter the name exactly as it should appear on the register.

Step 3 Enter the details of the proposed business name holder

Depending on the type of holder, details may include the:

- full name, date and place of birth, and residential address of individuals
- ACN or ARBN of companies or registered bodies, or
- organisation representatives for organisations that are not companies or registered bodies (do not have an ACN or ARBN)

Step 4 Enter the addresses of the business

You will need to provide:

- a street address for the service of documents
- a street address for the principal place of business, and
- an email address

You can also provide a mobile phone number for SMS reminders.

Step 5 Confirm eligibility to hold a business name

You will be asked to make specific declarations before you lodge the application including a declaration that the proposed business name holder (or any person involved in the management of the business) is not [disqualified under the Business Names Registration Act 2014](#).

Step 6 Review and change the information if required

You will have the opportunity to double-check all the information you have entered and edit it if required.

Step 7 Declare

You will be asked to declare that you understand the terms of lodgement of the application and that the information provided is true and correct. If you are lodging this application on behalf of the proposed holder, you will be asked to declare that you have the appropriate authority to lodge and make declarations on their behalf.

Step 8 Pay the registration fee

Have your Visa or MasterCard ready to pay the registration fee, or pay by BPay. If you choose to pay later you will need to provide an email address so we can send you an invoice. We must receive payment within 10 business days or we won't register the name.

2 Important considerations

There are a number of things you should be aware of before you register a business name.

Read and tick all boxes.

Registering a business name does not give the holder exclusive name rights. The holder may be subject to legal action for using a business name that has the potential to mislead a public.

The holder may be inadvertently infringing someone else's trade mark with the proposed business name. Choosing a business name that infringes an existing trade mark can be a costly exercise—it could mean hefty legal bills, drawn out disputes and even the closure of the business. That is why it's so important to undertake a trade mark (TM) check. [Visit IP Australia to search trademarks](#).

A holder that is part of a franchise needs consent from the franchise owner to use the business name. [Visit the Franchise Council of Australia for more information about franchises](#).

The holder should check for any state or territory business licences that may be required. Get tailored information about government-related licences, registrations and permits at the [Australian Business Licence and Information Service \(ABLIS\)](#).

The holder may want to register a domain name in addition to the business name. For more information and to search for available domain names before applying for a business name see the [Australian Domain Name Information \(ADANI\)](#).



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

Business name transfer

1. Enter the business name being transferred. Ensure the name is entered exactly as it appears on our register. Select **Check Name Availability**.
2. **Enter the transfer number.** The transfer number is provided by the previous business owner and is your authority to register the business name. Without this number you cannot complete your application.

Once obtained, enter the transfer number in the format provided - the number '1' followed by 11 digits (eg. 1-12345678912).
3. Select your preferred registration period (1 year or 3 years).
4. Select **Next** to continue.

You can [request an alternative registration period](#) for your business name to end on:
