October 19-22 (Hong Kong)	<p><b>IOSCO Board Meeting - 20-21 October</b></p> <p>The Board meeting focused primarily on discussing IOSCO's priorities for 2017.</p> <p>The Board was also asked to note progress and provide guidance on a number of high priority FSB driven projects (including work to address the risks posed by CCP's, vulnerabilities in asset management and market conduct).</p> <p>The Board also progressed important capacity building and co-operation initiatives, including the establishment of the first IOSCO Regional Hub in Kuala Lumpur, further developing an online capacity building tool kit and finalising arrangements to upgrade the MMoU on enforcement co-operation.</p> <p><b>Salzburg Global Forum - Finance in a Changing World – 21 October</b></p> <p>The Salzburg Global Forum on Finance is a regular gathering of public and private sector thought leaders to discuss developments in financial markets and their link to global economic growth.
