ASIC's interim report dated **17 April 2019** on compliance with the s93AA ASIC Act court enforceable undertaking (CEU) given by **Christopher John Cannon** dated 19 December 2017.

Terms used in this report have the same meaning as in the CEU dated 19 December 2017.

Undertakings	Report on compliance
Appointment of Independent Expert CEU paragraph 13 - 19	 Mr Cannon appointed and retained an independent expert within 30 days of the CEU acceptance date and sought ASIC approval of the terms of engagement of the expert, in writing, prior to the independent expert being engaged. Mr Cannon has provided reasonable assistance and access to the independent expert and made his client files available.
Assessment of Independent Expert CEU paragraph 20 – 21.2	 The independent expert has: reviewed 5 of Mr Cannon's Financial Product Advice files and provided a report to Mr Cannon, ASIC and Mr Cannon's current Australian financial services licensee, MyPlanner Professional Services Pty Ltd regarding his compliance with sections 947D, 961B, 961G and 961J of the Corporations Act 2001; and assessed whether Mr Cannon has met his ongoing training requirements.
