THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

Living expenses of the first defendant

1. Until further order, upon the funds available to the receivers from the bank accounts held in the name of the first defendant being exhausted, no further payment or allowance shall be made for living expenses of the first defendant and, at that time, and to the extent necessary, the following orders in relation to the first defendant's future living expenses be vacated:

- (a) Order 1(b) of the Orders made on 17 December 2020; and
- (b) Order 11(c)(i) of the Orders made on 10 November 2020 as varied by the 17 December 2020 Orders.

Legal expenses of the first defendant

2. Until further order, upon the funds available to the receivers from the bank accounts held in the name of the first defendant being exhausted, no further payment or allowance shall be made for legal expenses of the first defendant and, at that time, and to the extent necessary, the following orders in relation to the first defendant's future legal expenses be vacated:

- (a) Order 1(a) of the Orders made on 17 December 2020; and
- (b) Order 11(a) of the Orders made on 10 November 2020 as varied by the 17 December 2020 Orders.



3. The plaintiff to advise the first defendant if there is a change in the plaintiff's knowledge as to the availability of funds in bank accounts held in the name of the first defendant within three business days of the plaintiff becoming so aware.
4. The first defendant has liberty to apply to the Court (including in circumstances where there is a change in the plaintiff's knowledge as to the availability of funds in bank accounts held in the name of the first defendant) to reinstate or vary any orders made by the Court as to living expenses and legal expenses of the first defendant, on three business days' notice.
