THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

Extension of travel restraint and freezing orders

1. The dates in paragraphs:
 - a. 8, 10, 11 and 13 of the orders made on 23 June 2025 in this proceeding; and
 - b. 1, 6, 7 and 8 of the orders made on 26 June 2025 in this proceeding,be extended, or further extended to 4.00 pm on 31 July 2026.

Cemetery plots

2. Subject to paragraph 3 below, the third Defendant have permission to surrender, to the Southern Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust, the third defendant's rights of internment reserved at the Springvale Botanical Cemetery for a refund.
3. The proceeds of the refund for the rights of internment be disbursed directly to a bank account controlled by the Receiver and held and applied in accordance with the orders made on 26 June 2025 and 22 August 2025.

Superannuation

4. Subject to paragraph 5 below, the third defendant have permission to take steps to recover any unclaimed superannuation held on his behalf by the Australian Tax Office.



5. Any unclaimed superannuation withdrawn by the third defendant be disbursed directly to a bank account controlled by the Receiver and held and applied in accordance with the orders made on 26 June 2025 and 22 August 2025.

Other

6. There be liberty to apply.
7. Costs be reserved.
