THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

1. The date in paragraph 4 of the orders made by the Honourable Justice Button on 2 March 2026 (by which the parties are to file a statement of agreed facts and admissions and joint submissions) be extended from 4:00pm on 4 May 2026 to **4:00pm on 18 May 2026**.
2. By **4:00pm on 25 May 2026**, the Plaintiff is to file (by providing to the Associate to the Honourable Justice Button):
 - a. an electronic joint bundle of authorities comprising:
 - i. a combined list of authorities upon which the parties intend to rely; and
 - ii. electronic copies of those authorities; and
 - b. an electronic Court Book.
3. The joint bundle of authorities and Court Book are to be prepared in accordance with Format 2 of the eBooks Practice Note (GPN-eBooks).
4. The Format 2 joint bundle version of authorities will also include:
 - a. a separate column in the hyperlinked index specifying which party relies on the authority and the relevant pinpoint reference(s); and
 - b. bookmarks for pinpoint references, using nested bookmarks.
5. Liberty to apply.
