

ASIC industry funding: Annual dashboard report 2023-24

We must publish an annual dashboard report each year, setting out our regulatory costs for the previous financial year: see s138 of the *Australian Securities and Investments Commission Act 2001*. Table 1 and Table 2 comprise the annual dashboard report for 2023–24.

Table 1 shows how we have apportioned our regulatory costs in 2023–24 for each sector by the type of activity undertaken and the different kinds of expenses we have incurred.
