THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

Further and Better Particulars

1. By 4:30pm on 13 July 2026, the defendant file and serve its response to the request for further and better particulars of the defence dated 27 May 2026.

Lay Evidence

2. By 4:30pm on 18 September 2026, the defendant file and serve a list of documents on which it intends to rely at the hearing on liability and any lay evidence in chief.
3. By 4:30pm on 18 December 2026, the plaintiff file and serve a list of further documents in reply on which it intends to rely at the hearing on liability and any lay evidence in reply.

Expert evidence

4. By 4:30pm on 4 November 2026, the defendant file and serve any expert reports.
5. By 4:30pm on 18 December 2026, the plaintiff file and serve any expert reports in reply.

Hearing on liability only

6. The matter is listed for a hearing on liability only commencing on a date to be fixed.



Statement of Agreed Facts

7. By 4:30pm on 12 February 2027, the plaintiff serve on the defendant a draft Statement of Agreed Facts on the question of liability.
8. By 4:30pm on 26 February 2027, the defendant serve on the plaintiff any proposed changes to the draft Statement of Agreed Facts on the question of liability.
9. By 4:30pm on 5 March 2027, the parties are to confer, and if agreement can be reached, file any Statement of Agreed Facts on the question of liability.

Tender lists

10. By 4:30pm on 12 March 2027, the plaintiff serve on the defendant a consolidated tender list of the documents it proposes to tender at the hearing on liability identifying:
 - (a) the documents that the plaintiff seeks to tender because they are referred to in an expert report filed by the plaintiff; and
 - (b) the documents that the plaintiff otherwise will seek to tender at the hearing on liability or rely upon in cross-examination, identifying for each such document:
 - (i) the part or parts of the document upon which the plaintiff will seek to rely; and
 - (ii) the basis for the relevance and admissibility of the document.
11. By 4:30pm on 25 March 2027, the defendant serve on the plaintiff a consolidated tender list of the documents it proposes to tender at the hearing on liability identifying:
 - (a) the documents that the defendant seeks to tender because they are referred to in an expert report filed by the defendant; and
 - (b) the documents that the defendant otherwise will seek to tender at the hearing on liability or rely upon in cross-examination, identifying for each document:
 - (i) the part or parts of the document upon which the defendant will seek to rely; and



(ii) the basis for relevance and admissibility of the document.

12. By 4:30pm on 5 April 2027, the plaintiff serve on the defendant any supplementary tender list in reply of documents it proposes to tender at the hearing on liability or rely upon in cross-examination identifying the matters in orders 10(a) and 10(b).

Court Book

13. By 4:30pm on 21 April 2027, the plaintiff serve on the defendant a list of the documents it proposes to include in the court book for the purpose of the hearing on liability, which are to be the documents identified in the consolidated tender list or supplementary tender list of each party (unless a party gives notice to the other party that it no longer intends to rely upon a document).
14. By 4:30pm on 28 April 2027, the defendant notify the plaintiff of any proposed amendments to the draft index to the court book.
15. By 4:30pm on 30 April 2027, the parties confer to finalise the draft index to the court book.
16. By 4:30pm on 3 May 2027, the plaintiff file and serve a copy of the electronic court book in accordance with Format 1 of the eBooks Practice Note (GPN-eBOOKS).

Case Management

17. The proceeding is listed for a case management hearing at 10.00am on 9 April 2027, at which time the parties are to be prepared to address the Court regarding the date on which the hearing on liability is to be fixed and the estimated length of that hearing and the Court will make orders for the preparation of the proceeding for hearing.

Other orders

18. Costs reserved.
