#### CATSI Act Section 487-10 NOTICE OF DETERMINATION AND APPOINTMENT **WALHALLOW ABORIGINAL CORPORATION** ICN 69 WHEREAS:

A. A show cause notice under section 487-10 of the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act) was served on the Walhallow Aboriginal Corporation (ICN 69) (the corporation) on 9 September 2022.

B. Having considered the representations made by the corporation, as a delegate of the Registrar of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Corporations (the Registrar), I am satisfied that one or more of the grounds specified in section 487-5 of the CATSI Act have been established.
