WHEREAS:

A. A show cause notice under section 487-10 of the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act) was served on the Walhallow Aboriginal Corporation (ICN 69) (the corporation) on 9 September 2022.
