

How to invite someone to connect to an entity

ASIC Regulatory Portal user guide | Version 1.2, March 2024



You must have Senior Administrator or Administrator access for an entity to have the ability to invite users to connect to that entity.

- 1. Log in to the ASIC Regulatory Portal
- 2. Select the **entity** you wish to invite the user to connect to.

3. On the entity page, click on **Administration** in the top navigation bar and select **Users** from the drop-down menu.

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4. On the **Users** tab, click on the **Invite new user to entity** button.



5. Fill in the invitee details. Mandatory fields are marked with a red asterisk (*).

The name and email address entered in the invitation must match:

- the name and email address entered at registration (if the invitee does not have an existing portal account); or
- the name and email address on the invitee's existing portal account (if the invitee has already registered).

You will also be asked to allocate an Access level. These are:

- Administrator can launch, edit and submit a transaction, and invite other users with an Approver or Editor Access level to the entity.
- Approver in general, can launch, edit and submit a form or transaction.
- Editor in general, can launch and edit a form or transaction, but they cannot submit it.

See the full list of <u>Access levels</u> for more information on what each level can do in the portal.

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You **cannot** invite a user to connect as a Senior administrator.

This access level is generally reserved for the following users: individual licence holders (e.g. self-managed superannuation fund (SMSF) auditors, registered company auditors, Australian financial services (AFS) licensees, Australian credit licensees, liquidators); officeholders of a company (e.g. director, secretary); and partners of a partnership. The correct connection validation must be conducted to grant this access level. For more information, see our <u>How to connect to an entity</u> user guide.

6. Read and make the declaration that you understand the Access level you are allocating, click the **check box** and select **Confirm**.



We email the invitee an invitation key that will enable them to connect to the entity.
