1. Pursuant to rule 30.01 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth) and section 37P(2) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth), the question of whether the defendant has contravened the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), as alleged in the originating process dated 12 November 2025, be heard and determined separately and in advance of the question of whether any relief should be granted, and if so, the nature of the relief.

3. By 4:00pm on 17 April 2026, the defendant file and serve a defence.
4. By 4:00pm on 6 May 2026, the plaintiff file and serve a reply.
5. The case management hearing listed at 10:00am on 12 December 2025 is vacated.
6. The matter is listed for a further case management hearing at 9:30am on 15 May 2026.
7. Liberty to apply on 3 business days' notice.
