Dear ASIC Information Broker

ASIC updates information available through purchased extracts

There have been longstanding concerns about the availability of directors' personal information on ASIC business registers.

Today, ASIC has made important changes to remove the company officeholder address from the extracts we make available to the public.

This change addresses privacy and safety concerns including the potential to access personal information, heightened concerns around personal safety and to reduce the risk of identity theft and cyber-crime.

The data you receive through our online services will not change. You will continue to receive this information for identity validation, verification and due diligence purposes.

ASIC has been working to better understand the legitimate business and legal use cases for company officeholder address information. This week we will contact you to commence discussions on how you use this information, the impact of this change on your operations, and any adjustments you'll need to make to ensure that access to officeholder residential address information is limited to legitimate business and legal purposes.
