ASIC updates information available through purchased extracts

Thank you for our call this morning. As discussed, ASIC has made changes to current and historical companies register extracts to address concerns about the availability of directors' personal information on ASIC business registers.

While our program to uplift and stabilise the ASIC business registers (RegistryConnect) aims to support the delivery of a permanent solution (including through linking Director IDs), we've removed officeholder residential addresses from the current and historical company search extracts purchased through the ASIC website.

The removal of address information from the company extract is intended as immediate action to remove the most publicly available source of residential address information. It's not intended to remove residential address information entirely, nor will it affect ATO's access to this information.

ASIC has been working to better understand the legitimate business and legal use cases for company officeholder residential address information. Commencing this week, we will be having discussions with a range of ASIC data consumers to explain this change and to discuss the adjustments they will need to make to ensure that access to officeholder residential address information is limited to legitimate business and legal purposes.
