

In a meeting with Treasury today (including myself, § 22 and § 22 we were advised that there is a reasonable likelihood of being asked to cease publishing residential addresses on company extracts, potentially at very short notice.

FYI, I have asked a very small group of people in DD&T to undertake some preparatory work including continuing to identify and test potential solutions, and identifying corresponding updates to our website and channels, so we're well positioned to respond in the event that we do receive an urgent request from the government. Given the potential risk of making urgent changes with limited testing, I believe this preparatory work over the next few days including testing is a reasonable risk mitigation measure. Please let me know if any questions.
