Timing of removal	ASIC's consent to an auditor's removal cannot be back-dated.		
	When ASIC consents to a removal, our consent will take effect when all the conditions of ASIC's consent have been met. This will generally involve disclosure to the relevant market operator or to members of the scheme, by a public notice displayed prominently on the responsible entity's website where the notice can reasonably be readily located and accessed by members.		
	 The removal notice generally contains the following: details of the outgoing auditor; details of the proposed incoming auditor; and the reason for the change in auditor. 		
	Do not proceed on the assumption that ASIC's consent will be automatically granted. If ASIC does not grant its consent to the removal, the appointed auditor will continue to hold office as the scheme's compliance plan auditor.		
	As soon as practicable, after the removal of the compliance plan auditor, the responsible entity is required by s601HI to lodge a Form 5114 <i>Notification of request by responsible entity to change compliance plan auditor.</i>		
	For an auditor that is an auditor of the scheme's financial report, the responsible entity should apply for consent to remove using Form 5132 Application for consent from ASIC for resignation or removal of scheme auditor.
