PENAL NOTICE

THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

Travel Restraint Orders

- 1. Paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of the orders made on 19 June 2025 be vacated and the following orders made in substitution.
- 2. Pursuant to s 1323(3) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), each of the Defendants be restrained from leaving or attempting to leave Australia until 4.00 pm (AEDT) on 27 October 2025.
- 3. The Defendants be restrained from applying for the issue of an Australian or non-Australian passport or other document permitting international travel until 4.00 pm (AEDT) on 27 October 2025.
- 4. The documents delivered up to the Registry pursuant to paragraph 2 of the orders dated 26 March 2024 be held by the Registry until 4.00 pm (AEDT) on 27 October 2025.

Other

- 5. Paragraph 6 of the orders made on 19 June 2025 (*listing the proceeding for hearing at 9.00 am on 22 September 2025*) be vacated.
- 6. There be liberty to apply.
- 7. Costs be reserved.
