

CEU final compliance report by ASIC

ASIC's final report dated 12 July 2022 on compliance with the section 93AA ASIC Act court enforceable undertaking (CEU) given by Jenan Oslem Thorne (also known as Cenan Thorne and Cenan Dikmen).

Terms used in this report have the same meaning as in the CEU dated 13 February 2019.

ASIC's records indicate that Ms Thorne was not authorised as a representative under any AFSL and did not provide any financial services, as an employee or otherwise, for a period of three years from the commencement of the CEU.
Provision of information to clients within 28	1. An investigation by ASIC found evidence suggesting that Ms Thorne had failed to comply with paragraph 3.3. of the CEU.
days CEU paragraph 3.3	2. Civil proceedings were filed against Ms Thorne in the Federal Court of Australia on 17 November 2020. ASIC sought orders directing that Ms Thorne comply with paragraph 3.3 of the CEU, pursuant to section 93AA(4) of the ASIC Act.
	3. Orders were made on 11 March 2021, requiring that Ms Thorne take steps to comply with paragraph 3.3 of the CEU within five (5) business days of the date of the Order.
	4. ASIC has reviewed documents supplied by Ms Thorne pursuant to the Order and is satisfied that Ms Thorne has complied with this undertaking.

	3. Orders were made on 11 March 2021, requiring that Ms Thorne take steps to comply with paragraph 3.4 of the CEU within 20 business days of the date of the Order.
